# Synod Voting

Previously, judgment voting closed approximately four hours after the judgment was raised, or until a greater majority was reached, whichever came first. We are trying something slightly different this time to make things clearer and simpler for all.

A Judgment raised	Will close at
On Friday night	2pm on Saturday
Before 2pm on Saturday	6pm on Saturday
Before 6pm on Saturday	10pm on Saturday
Before 10pm on Saturday	2pm on Sunday

In this way, a Synod Priest need only visit the Hub four times at a three day summit to be sure of being able to vote on everything they are eligible to vote on.

The exceptions to this are:

- \* The Veto. This will be as per the current process, i.e. it must receive a greater majority between the Senate session the motion was raised and the next session
- \* Decisive Majorities. The presence of over half an Assembly's voting strength in one go for an immediate outcome.
